205 9 Muses, Dry White (Central Greece) \$34 50% Assyrtiko, 30% Trebbiano, 20% Sauvignon Blanc. Bright yellow color with green tints. Intense fruity aromas on the nose, with a round, balanced body and a lingering after taste.	
207 Amthystos Blend (Macedonia, Greece) \$48 Sauvignon Blanc, Assyrtiko, Semillon. The un-oaked dry white has a big, bold and mouth-filling bouquet of peach, melon, and tropical fruits.	
209 Boutari Moschofilero (Greece) \$38 Known for its citrus and floral aromatics, Boutari Moschofilero is an excellent aperitif and pairs with delicate dishes such as sushi, salads or fresh fish.	
201 Elios (Central Greece) \$36 A pale straw color with aromas of citrus and melon and hints of honey and vanilla. On the palate, this wine is crisp and refreshing with a distinct green apple finish.	
203 Kourtakis Retsina (Central Greece) \$30 Retsina is a product unique to the Greek vineyards. It is a dry, slightly piquant wine, which owes its characteristic flavor to the addition of a few pieces of pine resin to the must before or during fermentation.	
208 Atlantis (Santorini) \$45 A Greek white wine from Santorini. This blend of Assyrtiko, Athiri, and Aidani is deliciously fragrant and full of exotic fruits and fresh florals, with lithe minerals on the end. Fruit-forward and fresh, this is an ideal match for white meats and seafood.	
212 Malamatina Restsina .375 (Greece) \$15 Malamatina is the Retsina of Macedonia, Greece.	
213 Thalastis Assyrtico (Greece) \$59 Thalassitis is a bone-dry wine with a strong character: full-bodied, well-structured with a crisp acidity, distinctive minerality and delicate honeysuckle aromas.	
211 Kretikos Blend (Greece) \$34 Intense fruity aromas of citrus trees, pineapple, peach and grapefruit. A fresh wine with a pleasant taste and a long aromatic finish.	
219 Kendal Jackson Chardonnay (California) \$46 Beautifully integrated tropical flavors such as pineapple, mango, and a papaya with citrus notes that explode in your mouth.	
266 Josh Chardonnay (California) \$38 Ripe citrus summer fruit, peach, pear, aligned with a touch of vanilla and smoke, partially barrel fermented. The well balanced acidity supports a core of pear and sweet melon and complements a creamy texture. Has a clean and refreshing finish.

126 Carr Cabernet (Napa Valley) \$48 The wine shows great balance and density, silky fine grain tannins with anis, clove, cherry, and black currant in a long finish.	
106 Cava Amthystos Cabernet (Macedonia) \$90 Aged 18 months in a new oak, then two years in the bottle. This wine has a spicy and exciting bouquet, reminiscent of the chocolate, coffee, raspberry and gooseberry, with strong tannins evoking a long finish.	
105 Amthystos Red (Macedonia) \$59 This dry red is aged in French oak and is velvety with flavors of red forest fruits, notably black berry and gooseberry.	
111 Kretikos Boutari (Crete) \$31 Vibrant red colour, pleasant aroma of sweet red fruit, like cherry and strawberry. Mild taste with soft tannins, good acidity, very good balance and aromatic aftertaste.	
114 Nemea Boutari (S. Greece) \$38 This is an exceptional, round, well balanced, velvety wine of sweet aromas. It's a ruby color with hints of new oak, plum, and cinnamon.	
113 Monemvasia Louloudi (Central Greece) \$45 Deep red color and complex nose, with notes of red fruit jams, dried figs, pepper, leather, and cocoa. Mouth relatively light, without special volume, soft and easy to drink.	
115 Notios Red (Peloponesus) \$39 A deeply colored wine with refreshing acidity, velvety mouth feel and intense and persistent aromas of ripe red fruit with elegant notes of butter caramel.	
103 9 Muses (Thespias) \$36 This wine is a bright red color with notes of red fruit and vanilla on the nose. The palate offers fresh acidity and a touch of spiciness with a medium long finish.	
128 Josh Cabernet (Sonoma) \$42 Aromas of ripe currant, smoke and saddle. Flavors of dark cherry and ripe plum with a hint of vanilla and cocoa. A firm and approachable structure with a balanced and long finish.	
300 Atlantis Red (Santorini) \$47 Full bodied with bright tannins, complex aromas of red fruit, with hints of prune and leather. The mouth is well structured and balanced, it has a velvety palate and a long finish.	
119 Uranos Blend (Greece) \$59 Gorgeous bouquet of fragrant red fruits, strawberry and violet. Seductively sweet but structured palate reminiscent of Cote de Nuits Burgandy. This is a very classy wine.	
127 Elios Blend (Greece) \$38 40% Agiorgitiko, 30% Cabernet, 30% Syrah. Soft berry notes, full of richness and hints of chocolate. Medium bodied with smooth tannins.
